**A TALE OF TWO DEALERS**

Something You Should Know



First the Problem and then the long version of the story. If you own an 2005 to 2009 Mustang should

beware. If the engine service light and the throttle light come on. Don't panic. The solution may be as simple as resetting the air cleaner, make sure everything is seated correctly. Then disconnect the battery and start the car. If both lights go out, the problem is solved. If they come back on, you do have a throttle problem and best to have it towed in. Now to my story and how I discovered this. I left the meeting after the meeting at Yogi's, an MCO sponsor, and made it do the freeway. As I accelerated, bingo the two lights blinked on. They seemed as bright as search lights, but the car was running fine, so I slowed down and decided home was within reach. Once at home, I called the Ford dealer who is open at night. The Service manager had no idea what the problem was, but she was going to ask. (exhibit: Service Mgr #1) She came back to the phone and assured me that Service Mgr #2 said it was a throttle problem and they could get me it on Thursday. Still a little nervous about driving back to the northend, I was up early and drove across the freeway to the west side dealer, where the car was purchased. Explained what had happened, and now Service Mgr #3, said he was sorry, but he couldn't hook it up until Tuesday, but he would drive me home. So I took the car home and waited for Advanced Auto Parts to open. They hooked up the computer to the car and gave me the two service codes. The throttle light was now off. Decision time. I limped the car back to the

northend, I like those mechanics better, or at least I did. Explained the two service codes to service mgr #4. Yes it was a throttle problem. Yes they would work it in Thursday or Friday. Friday came only two cars in front of me. The day came and went, even the night shift. No. Sorry, Saturday was booked. Monday came the call from Service Mgr #4 saying that he just discovered a service alert that snow or water getting into the air cleaner causes the lights to come on. Everyone knows that car was briefly snowed on during a St Patrick's Day Parade several years ago and if it wasn't for the Arthritis Show it hasn't been rained on. So five days in the hot sun for a car that is garaged day and night. And a charge for simply shaking the air cleaner box, something as a car guy I was very able to do myself.

So the moral, I guess. Before you trust your car to a factory Service Mgr, check the website for all the service alerts and notices. Because, from my experience, 4 out of 4 Service Mgrs have no idea what the problem really is.
